The Parties Involved - Funding Comparison

US Dept of Agriculture (USDA)

- Federal Loan/Grant: \$604,000/ \$604,000
- 50% must be Repaid 22 Years
- Complex Administration
- 22 Years of Reporting
- Extensive construction review
- Loan/Grant Agreement in place




ME Connectivity Authority

(MCA)

- State Grant: \$998,000
- No Repayments
- Simpler Administration
- Streamlined Reporting 5 Years
- Simpler, less expensive construction review
- Grant Approved; Signed Agreement Pending



Current Challenges







Make-Ready: <u>Done</u> as of July 13

- CMP has completed all power-line moves
- CCI phone-line moves (if any) do not delay fiber
- ABA has received CCI and CMP licenses to hang fiber

Construction Contract between ABA and Axiom

- Draft under legal review
- Final Terms to be agreed upon

Grant Agreement between ABA and MCA

- MCA funds received from Federal program
- Final MCA draft under legal review by Arrowsic


