### Meeting with Properties Committee

- Original proposal to add one more room to current shed. They supported the community's work.
- Thinking of relocating shed to bottom of hill between little fire barn and town hall. Currently it is non-conforming. There would be quite a bit of site work. Expansion at time of relocation would be fine. We should look at what we want for long term. Adding a swap room to promote re-use rather than recycling
- Using part of forestry barn may be an option. Space would have to be delineated
