#### Erica Bayley, Account Manager from Casella

- Discussed audit she had done with another town lots of contamination
- Discussed costs of recycling trucks, employees etc.
- Rumford Mill by 2019 be able to recycle paper and cardboard and fiber!
- Suggested that towns continue to recycle
- Short term markets. Plastic lots of buyers but market is saturated. Much cheaper to buy new than to buy recycled
- Three levels of contamination
  - A few bags of trash in a recycling dumpster
  - Recyclable materials (2" or smaller, tanglers etc.) that have an impact on the machines at Casella
  - Food waste, construction debris
- Need to be clean and dry careful on rainy days
- Luanne Montpas, Operations Assistant will be mailing our weights in January

#### Contamination discussion

- Confusion between John Hinds and trash hauler about contents of bags, whether they
  were trash or recycling.
- Educational opportunity for our town, recyclables should not be put out in trash bags. Insist with Craig no plastic bags in recycling. If it goes out in plastic bag, it will go into trash which is against town mandate to recycle.
- Long term solution we need a grant to purchase recycling bins for residents. Paul will research grant for bins.
- Correspondence with Craig, we want people to comply with Casella regulations. He may have a solution. Perhaps we should invite him to our January meeting to let him know that we asked townspeople to keep plastics out and we are going to look into a grant for recycling bins.

#### Town notice and new trash/recycling schedule to go out this week!

- Keep plastic bags out of recycling, keep recycling out of plastic bags
- Recycling needs to be clean and dry
